



Karen Aiach Presents at The Royal Society of Medicine

On April 22, 2017, Karen Aiach, Founder and CEO of Lysogene, gave a lecture to The Royal Society of Medicine as part of its 14th Medical Innovations Summit in London. The presentation, which she made with Dr. Michel Zerah, Professor of Neurosurgery at Necker Enfants Malades in Paris, reviewed Lysogene's efforts and progress developing gene therapy to treat young children who have been diagnosed with rare diseases affecting the central nervous system.

Ms. Aiach discussed the reasons behind the launch of the company, which she founded after learning of her own daughter's diagnosis with a rare condition, Sanfilippo Syndrome A; the work being done at Lysogene to develop a direct-to-brain treatment for this and related conditions; and the development of the associated surgical procedure.
